• Lorong Halus Wetland Carnival

On 24 March, in conjunction with the celebration of Singapore Water Day 2012, Public Utility Board (PUB) and National Environmental Agency (NEA) organized a Wow Wow Wet Carnival; at the event, Deputy Prime Minister, Teo Chee Hean

announced and welcomes SSMC's adoption of Lorong Halus Wetland and using its learning trail, as a platform for increasing environmental awareness both among its staff and with its community partners.

SSMC Environmental Committee supported this carnival by setting up a booth to showcase SSMC's environmental achievements. Our Management team members, Kelly Sofian and Collin Tan also supported our environmental committee members who shared our efforts in water conservation. We are proud to be the first in Singapore Semiconductor Industry to use NEWater for wafer processing as early as 2003. Since then, our Fab has achieved total saving of ~1 million cubic meters

of water equivalent to 400 Olympic size swimming pools. Also, SSMC is the first wafer Fab to install volatile organic carbon (VOC) abatement system in Singapore for VOC gases treatment; and waste water is treated before discharge.

More than 1,000 residents, joint by Ministers of Parliament, grassroot leaders, crews from PUB and NEA, as well as
