SSMC Never Stops Caring for Our Community

On 25 May, SSMC presented a donation of S\$8,000 to North East Community Development Council (NECDC) to support Dedicated NE Ambulance Programme in providing ambulance transport service for needy residents with mobility difficulties to attend the medical treatments for their chronic illnesses. The SSMC cheque was presented by Alice Cheng (HR Director & SRC Sponsor) to NECDC General Manager, Kelvin Thong. Together with SSMC's contribution, the Dedicated NE Ambulance Programme exceeded its combined donation target to reach well over S\$53,000 and can provide more than 800 rides (return trips) for the underprivileged!
